

PARASAIL TRIMMING INSTRUCTIONS

WATERBIRD AND REGULAR FALCON CHUTES DO NOT HAVE ZIPPERED VENTS FOR TRIMMING. HOWEVER, FALCON DIAMOND SERIES HAVE ZIPPERED VENTS AS STANDARD.

THESE ZIPPERS ARE FOR TRIMMING ONLY. NOT TO BE USED TO TRY TO CREATE LIFT.

LIFT IS CREATED BY PASSING MORE AIR THROUGH THE CHUTE, NOT LESS. THEREFORE, IF IT IS NECESSARY TO TRIM YOUR CHUTE, USE THE TRIM ZIPPERS LOCATED ON EITHER SIDE OF THE CHUTE AS SHOWN IN THE DIAGRAM BELOW.

AS YOU ARE LOOKING AT THE CHUTE FROM THE BOAT...

PROBLEM ; slight bias in chute causing it to fly off axis. Bias is allowing too much air to pass through the opposite side of the chute, causing rotation.

SOLUTION: restrict air flow to counteract bias. Close vent on opposite side

USE ZIPPER AND ZIP TOWARDS SKIRT OF CHUTE UNTIL CHUTE FLIES STRAIGHT, THIS APPLIES TO THE FALCON DIAMOND SERIES. HOWEVER, WITH THE WATERBIRD AND REGULAR FALCON SERIES, USE SAFETY PINS AND THEN STITCH TO HOLD VENT CLOSED. PIN FROM APEX TO SKIRTING, CLOSELY SEALING AIR ESCAPE, USE ONLY 1" PINS, NO LARGER.
